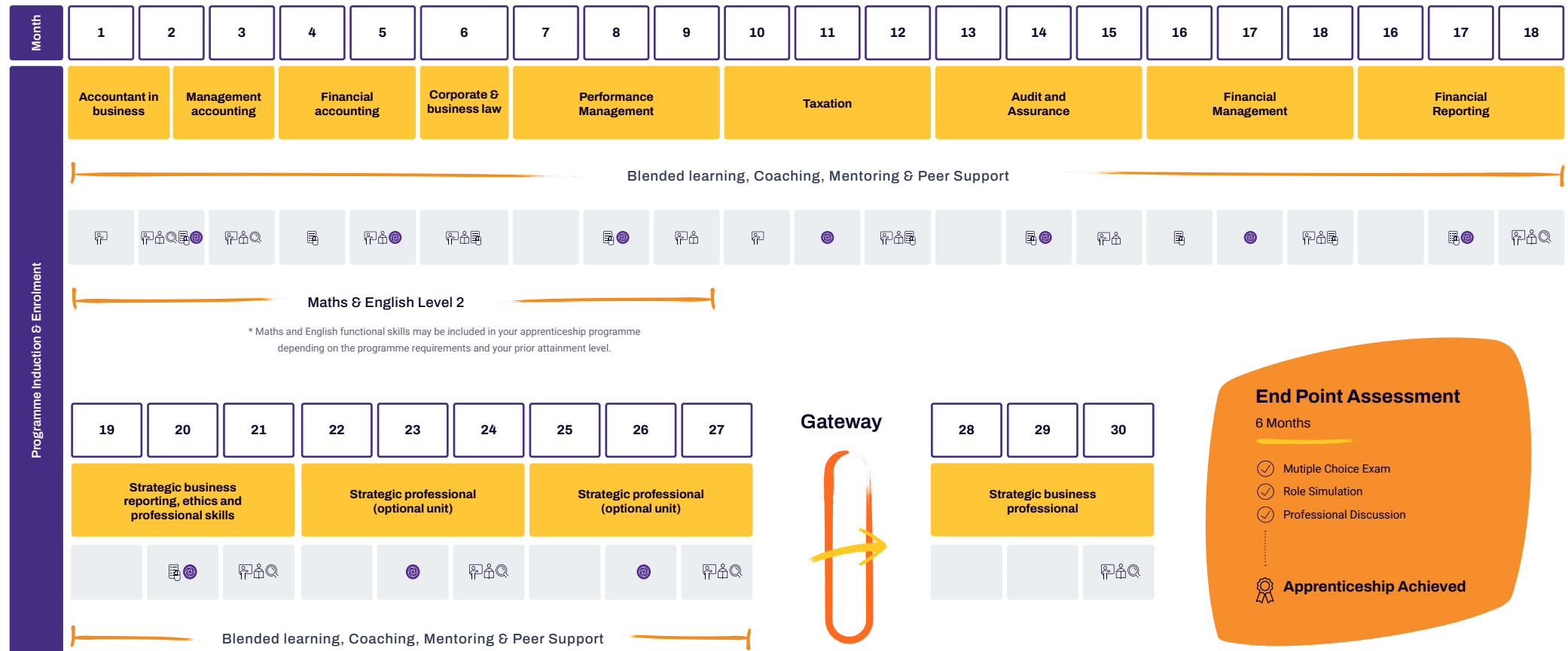

CIMA qualification leading to Chartered Management Accountantship

As accountants in business, Management Accountants need to understand how businesses operate, how they are managed, how people work together and how strategy is formulated. They also need to be able to provide the analysis which managers need to understand the economics of a businesses' operations, to manage performance and to manage risk.

These capabilities are in addition to the core technical financial accounting skills expected of a professional accountant. The qualification is broken down into 4 levels and is structured around 3 pillars that work across all levels. The levels being:

- Certificate, Operational, Management and Strategic - with the pillars running through the levels being enterprise, financial and performance.

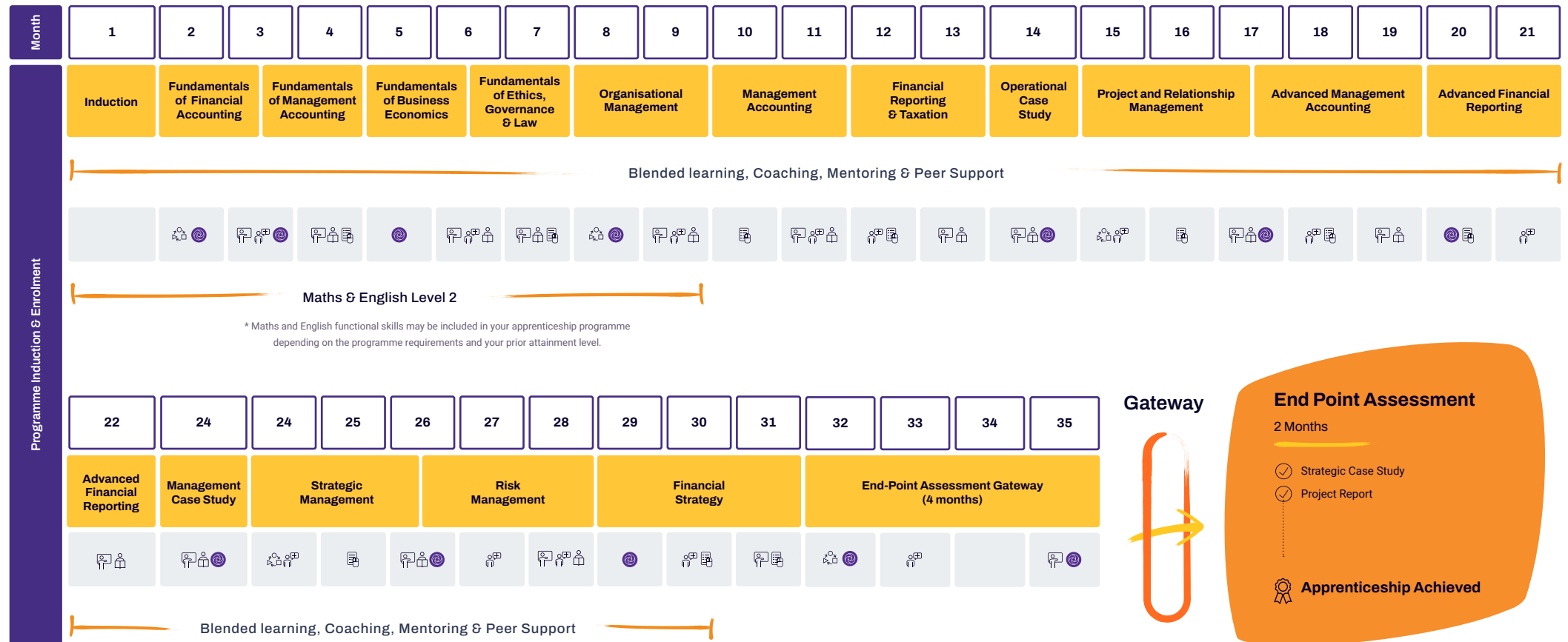
