An Operations or Departmental Manager is someone who manages a team and supports the wider business in the completion of projects and the achievement of operation or departmental goals and objectives, as part of the delivery of the organisation's strategy.

## Introduction to the course

Leadership and management skills have a major impact on the development, productivity and performance of organisations of all sizes and in all sectors. This CMI Level 5 apprenticeship will equip learners to develop skills in strategic planning, alongside core leadership abilities, to produce effective results as part of the organisation's wider strategy.

Key responsibilities may include creating and delivering operational plans; managing projects; leading and managing teams; managing change; financial and resource management; talent management; coaching and mentoring.

## Learner outcomes

Learners will learn to understand operational management approaches and models, including creating plans to deliver objectives and setting KPIs.

The course will cover project management tools and techniques, in addition to financial matters including budget management and forecasting.

Learners will also hone their skills in communication, timemanagement and decision-making, learning to build effective relationships at all levels.

There is also an option to incorporate the CMI Level 5 Certificate in Management and Leadership into this apprenticeship.

#### Assessment

Learners will be assessed through on-programme learning, developing their learning journal, before progressing to the end point assessment where they will be required to submit a 4000 word project proposal. Learners will also have a 1-hour professional discussion on the portfolio and a 20-minute presentation and 40-minute question and answer session.

Learners must achieve Level 2 English and Mathematics before completing the programme.


