Introduction to the course

The Level 4 Associate Project Manager apprenticeship is aimed at those involved in all levels of project management, enabling them to work effectively and efficiently to ensure their organisation operates successfully.

The course will explore different organisational structures, responsibilities and stakeholders and demonstrate the importance of project management planning and project communication plans.

In addition to more traditional leadership skills, learners will manage projects in line with wider business issues and benefits management, to ensure the most effective use of time and resources.

Learner outcomes

Learners will progress through a series of modules covering core skills in the project planning process. They will work through the project definition, concept and development phase before looking at the project handover.

Learners will also learn about budget management and cost control and to consolidate plans to support over all management objectives.

Assessment

During the course, learners will have the option to study one of two pathways:

- Non-Professional Qualification pathway
- Professional Qualification pathway (APM or PRINCE2 Foundation)

Learners will require to produce a portfolio of work based evidence, and complete an End-Point Assessment consisting of a presentation and professional discussion.

- Project Team Leader
- Project Manager
- Technical or Associate Project Manager

What's next?

On completion, learners will be eligible to register for Associate Membership of the Project Management Association (APM).

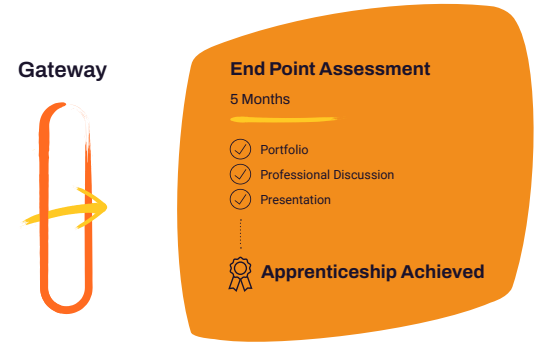
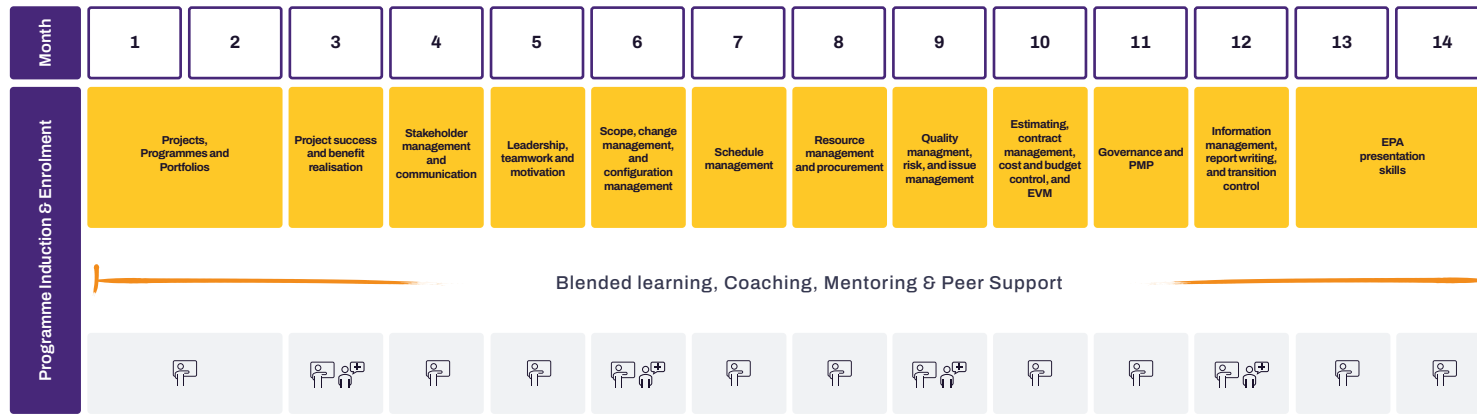
